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## WYMESWOLD PARISH COUNCIL ON FACEBOOK

Earlier this year, Wymeswold Parish Council was successful in securing a grant of £3265 from **Charnwood Borough Council** to create and stock a flood locker - a secure and waterproof storage unit for equipment needed by our village Flood Wardens during periods of flooding. Plans for this have been going on behind the scenes.

This week we signed an agreement with **Wymeswold Methodist Church** to refurbish an old storage building on their grounds for this purpose.

The Parish Council and the local Methodist community are delighted to be working in partnership on this mutually beneficial scheme, enabling the refurbishment of a dilapidated part of the church premises so that it can be put to good use to support local residents during flooding events. A win-win situation for all! The Methodist Connexional Conservation Officer, Joanne Balmforth, described this as 'a wonderful new use for a charming little appendage'.

The locker will be perfectly sited for ease of use, being immediately adjacent to the area most likely to flood but also on raised ground that is safe from flooding. The Parish Council hope to have the flood locker up and ready to use well in advance of any autumn flooding events. Further updates to follow.

A huge thank you to **Wymeswold Methodist Church** and the Wymeswold Flood Wardens for all their hard work with this project.
